1. High Court Civil Rules and Order: Rule-466(2): Court's important orders has to be shown and signed by the lawyer concerned - copies of the application to the court to be served on the party or his pleader. | **36 DLR 253**
2. High Court Civil Rules and Order: Rule-466(2) with Civil Rule and Orders: Rule-388(2): **Communication of Orders**: Effect of absence of communication of court's orders to a party another of court affecting one of the pillars of the suit is meant for communication to all parties concerned | **44 DLR(AD) 13**
3. C.R.O. Rule-388(2): Transfer of a case from one court to another court on an off date must be communicated either to the party concerned or to his advocate. | **4 CLR(AD) 406, 7 ALR(AD) 204, 6 ALR(AD) 200, 1 LM(AD) 164**
4. High Court Civil Rules and Order: Rule- 466(2): Court's order passed in absence of parties and not conveyed to them- subsequent order made on basis of the order, held, void and illegal. | **PLD 1963Dacca 987**
